Set Up Your iPhone 3G with Jaymunda Exchange via ActiveSync

1. On the Home screen, tap “Settings”; the Settings screen will appear
2. Tap Mail, Contacts, Calendars
3. Tap Add Account...
4. Tap “Microsoft Exchange” (enter the following information)
 - Email Address: <your Jaymunda Exchange Email Address>
 - Username: <your Jaymunda Exchange login>
 - Domain: <MSE22>
 - Password: <your Jaymunda Exchange Password>
 - Description: <add a description>
5. **NOTE:** Users with the older 1.0 software will not be prompted to enter a Domain. In this case, the Username will be “MSE22\<your Jaymunda Exchange Login>”
6. Tap “Next”
7. The following screen may appear: “Unable to Verify Certificate: While automatically discovering account settings, the certificate from “Jaymunda Exchange.com” could not be verified” This is due to the fact that the iPhone tries to verify network information and configure your account through an autodiscovery service. This service does not work with Microsoft Exchange.
8. Click “Accept” on the Error Message
9. A new screen will appear, with a new field called “Server.” For the server enter **mail.mse22.exchange.ms**
10. Tap “Next”
11. Choose which types of Exchange data you wish to have synched to the
12. iPhone (Email, Calendar, Contacts).
13. Tap “Save”
14. Your iPhone should now sync with your Jaymunda Exchange Hosted Exchange account.
